

## Men's League Regulations

Please note the Men's League regulations have been amended for the 2021/22 informal season in order to assist and encourage play.

Please refer to the main League Rules for more general rules which apply in relation to e.g. score sheets, registrations, disputes and rearrangements.

1. For the 2021/22 informal season only, ALL registered men (*see main League Rules, section 6*) can be eligible to play for the Men's League in addition to the Mixed league. However, those clubs with a high number of men registered are encouraged to share match play amongst players if possible.
2. Completed registration forms should be sent to the Match Secretary 7 days prior to the first fixture. Please refer to the main League Rules section 6 re. new/amendments to registrations.
3. Matches to consist of six events as follows:  
Four men playing six crossover doubles (AB, CD, AC, BD, AD & BC) against their opposite numbers in best of three games played in accordance with the Rally Points Scoring System.
4. Each team shall score one point for each game won in the match. The team with the highest number of points scored shall be the winner. The match result shall be the number of games won/lost.
5. Score sheets, which can be downloaded from the Members Area of the website, shall be completed and jointly signed by both captains at the end of the match. Both the home and away captains shall forward a copy of the score sheet to Lyn Brown ([lynbrown68@gmail.com](mailto:lynbrown68@gmail.com)) to be received within 5 days of the match.
6. The home team captain to enter the match result on the website within 5 days of the match being played.
7. Please refer to the main League Rules section 9 re. fixture rearrangements.
8. Please refer to the main League Rules section 10 re. in the event of a dispute.
